The Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa resolves to welcome the Hon' able President Xi Jinping of People's Republic of China on his visit to Pakistan accompanied by a high-powered delegation. During his visit, it is expected that a number of important agreements and Memorandums of Understanding will be signed between the two countries. This Assembly believes that this visit, apart from further strengthening the bond of longstanding friendship between the neighbors, will also pave the way for ensuring greater Chinese investment in Pakistan. This Assembly urges the Federal Government that while signing the investment agreements and MoUs during the same visit, the problems and miseries of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and its adjoining tribal belt must not be overlooked at any cost rather this region's vulnerability to extremism, terrorism and backwardness should be highlighted so as to secure more investment for Khyber and FATA. This Assembly further demands that the western route for China-Pakistan-Economic-Corridor (CPEC) should be included in the Early Harvest Plans relating to CPEC.
