

# PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA.

## SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE 13<sup>th</sup> SESSION

Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2010

During discussion on cut-motion in respect of demand No: 2, Mr. Abdul Akbar Khan, MPA pointed out that under the Constitution (Eighteenth Amendment) Act, 2010, Article 129 of the Constitution has also been amended and the executive authority has to be extended by the Governor through the Provincial Government, consisting of the Chief Minister and Provincial Ministers, but like past when the Article ibid was not amended the executive authority was executed by the Governor through Secretaries which is now void and ultra Constitutional and sought ruling from the Chair in this regard by quoting the said Article.
