- On a point of order Mr. Abdul Akbar Khan, MPA raised that the Provincial Public Service Commission is conducting screening test on Saturday for the recruitment of doctors for the first time which is not mentioned in the relevant Act. He along with the treasury and opposition benches opposed the Commission's move, however Mr. Saqibullah Khan Chamkani and Malik Qasim Khan, MsPA supported the test and demanded Government that it should be declared compulsory for recruitment of doctors to ensure transparency. At this juncture the Chair directed the establishment Department to take up the issue with the Commission.
