Question	Answer
A. what has been done so far of the Uch Canal District Peshawar?	For Remodeling of Warsak Lift Canal (Uch Canal) in the Phase-I, installation of new pumps is contracted out in 2018 under Warsak Remodeling Project costing Rs. 865 Million. New imported pumps will be installed for which supply order has been placed by the contractor and the work is scheduled to be completed by June, 2020. Whereas in Phase-II, the Lift Canal would be Remodeled and its capacity would be enhanced from 200 to 290 cusecs.
B. Is true that during 2013 to 2018 eleven (11) Billion Rupees were announced for Uch Canal and then reduced to three (03) Billion Rupees?	It is not true, actually in the year 2017 the revised PC-I of Remodeling Project was approved by ECNEC with an estimated cost of Rs. 11.137 Billion out of which Rs. 2.5 Billion is allocated for Remodeling of Uch Canal, including upgradation of existing pump house, grid station and remodeling of Warsak Lift Canal (Uch Canal), in phases, whereas remaining amount has been allocated for the construction of Auxiliary Tunnel, Remodeling of Warsak Gravity Canal and other works.
C. If yes, then please provide the exact updated with full details of the projects?	Break up of Rs. 2.50 Billion Earmarked for Remodeling of Uch Canal (as per Revised Approved PC1) is as under  1. Up gradation of existing pump House= Rs. 1486.02 Million 2. Remodeling of Uch Canal= Rs. 1018.67 Million Total Rs. 2504.6 Million Rs. 2.50 Billion As already explained work on item No. 01 is already in progress as a Phase-I, whereas work at Sr.No. II would be executed as Phase-II after construction of Tunnel.
