THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE GENERAL CLAUSES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

N.-W.F.P. ORDINANCE NO. IX OF 2002.

AN ORDINANCE

further to amend the West Pakistan General Clauses Act, 1956.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the West Pakistan General Clauses Act, 1956 (W.P. Act VI of 1956), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of the North-West Frontier Province is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, as amended uptodate, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999, read with Article 4 of the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of the North-West Frontier Province is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Ordinance may be called the North-West Frontier Province General Clauses (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

- (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 3 of W.P. Act VI of 1956.— In the West Pakistan General Clauses Act, 1956 (W.P. Act VI of 1956), the existing section 3 shall be renumbered as sub-section (1) of that section and after sub-section (1), as so renumbered, the following new sub-section (2) shall be added, namely:
- "(2) Government shall, by notification in the Official Gazette, or by any other means available, ensure wide dissemination of all Circulars, Rules, Regulations and Instructions having the effect of law.".
