I would like to draw the attention of Minister for Local Government, Elections, and Rural Development to the issue of cat-eyes installed on the roads of Peshawar and other parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. These cat-eyes while initially intended to enhance road safety, have become a significant hazard for commuters and vehicles, causing damages to vehicles increasing the risk of accidents, and creating unnecessary inconvenience for the public. The cat-eyes installed on the roads have proven to be safety risk, Particularly for motorcyclists and smaller vehicles. Their protruding design often leads to loss of control, especially during night time or adverse weather condition. Numerous complaints have been received from citizen regarding damage to tyres and vehicle owners. The cat-eyes have failed to serve their intended purpose of improving road safety. Instead, they have become nuisance, contributing to traffic disruptions and accidents. Residents of Peshawar and other districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa have repeatedly raised concerns about the cat-eyes and have demanded their removal to ensure safer and smoother travel. I urge the Minster to direct the Peshawar Development Authority (PDA) and relevant Local Government departments to immediately remove all cat-eyes from the roads of Peshawar and other districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The department should explore and implement alternative road safety measures that are more effective and less hazardous to commuters and vehicles. The department should also launch an awareness campaign to inform the public about the steps being taken to address this issue and ensure their safety. I trust that the Honorable Minister will take immediate action to address this and ensure the safety and convenience of the citizens of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
