In this regard the articulars of the following 22 deads along with 4 additional deac major injured received from different hospitals not included in the victims' list of the subject blast are sent herewith for further necessary action. Moreover it is also stated that a list of dead victim sent by your office to the the Sindh Government consisting 95 Nos, whereas the list receivcontaining about 73 and remaining 22 persons are not included or missing. It is worth mentioning. that the source for sending the names of major injured to the Government of Sindh is not know.

The issue of re-construction of the temple of Hind Community in Karak has still not been resolved. Earlier effort to take the local community into confidence for the purpose of reconstruction had failed. On the last date of hearing we gave clear direction to the Provincial Government to take administrative

action for restoration of the temple but again the law officer states that efforts are again being made for amicable settlement of the dispute. This is not in consonance with our last order. The provincial Government is, therefore, directed to start reconstruction of the temple within a period of two weeks and submit report for our perusal in Chambers.

- 2. As regards the endowment fund, CMA No.1564/2015 has been field on behalf of the Federal Government stating therein that the Prime Minister of Pakistan has approved the contribution of one time grant of Rs.100 millions for initiation of funds with regard to rehabilitation measures for victims of terrorist attacks, subject to the condition that the Provincial Government KPK establishes a special fund for the purpose with an equal amount. On the last date of hearing we directed the Provincial Government of KPK to set up the fund in which the Federal Government shall make equal contribution. The Government of KPK has not set up the endowment fund as yet. The same be done within two weeks report of which be submitted for our perusal in Chambers.
 - 3. Dr. Ramesh Kumar has again pointed out that the 5% quota reserved for the minorities be specifically mentioned in the advertisement for filling up the posts; that no progress has been made for making out security plan for protection of worship places of the minorities. The same be put in place before the next date of hearing.

Punjab.

4. CMA No.1843/2015 has been filed on behalf of the Government of Punjab alongwith security plan for worship places



of the minorities. Dr. Ramesh Kumar is satisfied with the security plan; however, he pointed out that the Provincial Government should also in very clear terms mention 5% quota reserved for the minorities while advertising the vacancies. The learned law officer has been duly instructed in this behalf who shall communicate these directions to the Government of Punjab. As far as the changes in the curriculum are concerned, meetings are taking place between representatives of the minorities and officials of the Government of Punjab. The process shall be expedited and report of progress made shall be submitted within one month for our perusal in Chamber. This matter to the extent of the Province of Punjab is disposed of for the time being.

Sindh

5. Dr. Ramesh Kumar informed that during meeting with the Chief Secretary and IG Sindh in which representatives of the minorities were present, a direction was given to the IG Sindh to give complete security plan of the worship places within two months. As regards the curriculum, the same has been introduced for class 1 to 5 and the committee constituted for the purpose is considering changes in the upper classes. It has been further pointed out that 5% quota in jobs shall be very clearly specified in the advertisements.

Balochsitan

6. A security plan has been provided by the learned Law Officer to representative of the minorities. Dr. Ramesh Kumar, representative of the minorities is satisfied with the security plan. The direction with regard to the 5% quota as has been given in the



other Provinces shall also be adhered to in the Province of Balochistan.

7. Dr. Ramesh Kumar has informed that pursuant to the direction given by this Court, the Hindu Marriage Bill 2015, has been introduced in the Parliament. However, in order to give effect to the Act throughout the country each Provincial Assembly is required to pass resolution in terms of Article 144 of the Constitution. The Provincial Governments shall, therefore, consider moving the Provincial Assemblies for passing such a resolution. Report in this context shall be submitted to this Court on behalf of the Provincial Governments within a month.

- 8. Learned Law Officers on behalf of NADRA has submitted reply to the CMA No.1151/2015. The same be provided to Samuel Payara, Director HR.
- 9. The Government of Balochsitan and Punjab as well as NADRA shall submit reply to the application regarding registration of Christian marriages in the Province of Balochistan and Punjab.

THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA REHABILITATION OF MINORITIES (VICTIMS OF TERRORISM) ENDOWMENT FUND ACT, 2020 (KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ACT NO. LI OF 2020)

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the Gazette of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, (Extraordinary), dated the 31st December, 2020).

AN ACT

to provide for the establishment of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund for rehabilitation of minorities victims of terrorism in the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the establishment of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund for the welfare and wellbeing of the minorities victims of terrorism and their family members in order to enable them to lead a prosperous life in the society and to provide them financial support and compensation for matters connected therewith and ancillary thereto;

It is hereby enacted by the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as follows:

- 1. Short title, extent, application and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rehabilitation of Minorities (Victims of Terrorism) Endowment Fund Act, 2020.
 - (2) It shall extend to the whole Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (3) It shall apply to the minority victims of terrorism in the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (4) It shall come into force at once.
- Definition.--- In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Bank" means any scheduled bank or a financial institution;
 - (b) "Committee" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund Assessment Committee, constituted under section 7 of this Act:
 - (c) "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Committee;

(d) "family members" mean father, mother and husband or wife, as the case may be, real children and step children, sisters and minor brothers, residing with and wholly dependent upon the victim:

Provided that real sons and step sons shall cease to be dependent on attaining the age of eighteen years daughters and step daughters shall cease to be dependent when they are married, unless they certifies to be dependent;

- (e) "Fund" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund, established under section 3 of this Act;
- (f) "Government" means the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (g) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules;
- (h) "Province" means the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (i) "rules" mean the rules made under this Act;
- (i) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Committee; and
- (k) "victim" means any person from the minorities, who has sustained injuries or caused death, in any act of terrorism.
- 3. Establishment of the Fund.—(1) Soon after the commencement of this. Act, Government shall establish a Fund to be known as the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund for victims, for the compensation, financial support, treatment, welfare and rehabilitation of the victims or their family members, as the case may be.
 - (2) The Fund shall be established with an initial capital of rupees two hundred (200) million and may, from time to time, be credited with-
 - (a) grants from Federal Government or Government;
 - (b) grants from philanthropists, non-government organizations and other organizations working for the welfare of the minority victims; and
 - (c) grants from any other legal source.

- The profit, accrued on the Fund, shall be utilized for the purposes as (3) provided in section 5 of this Act.
- Control and management of the Fund .--- The Fund shall be under the administrative control of the Committee and shall be kept in such Bank and invested in such a manner as may be determined by the Committee.
- Utilization of the Fund .--- The Fund shall be utilized for the treatment, 5. welfare, financial support, compensation and rehabilitation of the victims and their family members.
- Application .-- Application, for the purpose of section 5 of this Act, shall 6. be made to the Committee by the victim himself or in case of his death or disability, by his family members, in the manner as may be prescribed.
- Constitution of the Committee .-- (1) Government shall constitute a 7. Committee to be known as the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Endowment Fund Assessment Committee, for carrying out the purpose of this Act.
 - The Committee shall consist of-(2)
 - Chairman Minister/Advisor/Special Assistant Minority (a) Affairs;
 - Member Secretary to Government, Augaf, Haji. (b) Religious and Minority Affairs Department;
 - Members Four minority members of the Provincial (c) Legislature;

Khyber Administrator Augaf, The (d) Pakhtunkhwa;

Member

a representative of Finance Department of (e) Government, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary;

Member

a representative of Relief and Rehabilitation (f) Department of Government, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary;

Member

a representative of Health Department of Government, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary;

Member

Welfare Social representative of (h) Department of Government, not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary;

Member

Deputy Commissioner or his nominee not (i) below the rank of Additional Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District; and

Member

- (j) Deputy Secretary Auqaf, Hajj, Religious and Member-cum-Minority Affairs Department of Government. Secretary
- (3) The Chairman may nominate any other person as co-opted member.
- 8. Functions of the Committee.--The Committee shall-
 - (a) receive and scrutinize applications from the victims or their family members, as the case may be, for the purposes of section 5 of this Act;
 - (b) examine minutely the medical report or claims of the victims or their family members;
 - (c) ascertain the entitlement of the victims or their family members;
 - (d) verify the family members of a victims; and
 - (e) approve a specified amount for the purpose technical support, relief, welfare or compensation or rehabilitation of victims or their family members, as the case may be.
 - 9. Meetings of the Committee.—— (1) The Committee shall hold its a meetings at least on quarterly basis; provided that the Chairman may call meeting of the Committee at any time in case of emergency.
 - (2) The working paper alongwith agenda of the meeting shall be circulated at least ten days before the meeting; provided that this provision shall not apply in case of emergency meeting.
 - (3) The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Committee and in his absence, the member, nominated by the Chairman, shall preside over the meeting.
 - (4) The quorum for the meeting of the Committee shall be half number of the total members.
 - (5) The decisions of the Committee shall be taken by majority of its members present. In case of tie, the Chairman or the member presiding over the meetings may cast a second vote.
 - (6) The Secretary shall prepare the agenda and shall record the minutes of the meeting.
 - (7) The Committee shall evolve its own procedure for the conduct of its business under this Act.
 - (8) The Chairman and members of the Committee shall not be entitled for any remuneration for performance of duties under this Act.

- 10. Preference of family members in case of death of a victim.— In case of death of a victims the distribution of compensation amount among the family members and the preference to the family members shall be regulated in the manner as may be prescribed.
- 11. Limit of compensation amount.--- The victims or their family member shall be given such amount as compensation or financial support as may be prescribed.
- 12. Audit and accounts.--- (1) The Accounts of the Fund shall be audited by the Auditor General of Pakistan once in a financial year in the prescribed manner.
- (2) The Committee shall be responsible to maintain the accounts of the Fund in such form and in such manner as may be prescribed.
- (3) The amount, from the Fund, shall not be withdrawn, unless it is approved by the Committee.
- (4) Withdrawal of amount from the Fund shall be permissible only under the joint signatures of the Chairman and Member-cum-Secretary of the Committee.
- (5) In case of emergency, the Chairman may make payments of the emergent nature, which shall later on, be placed before the Committee for approval in its next meeting.
- 13. Power to make rules.---Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rehabilitation of Minorities (Victims of Terrorism) Endowment Fund Rules, 2021.

- Short title, and commencement.— These rules may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rehabilitation of Minorities (Victims of Terrorism) Endowment Fund Rules, 2021.
- 2. Definition.— (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise require.-
 - "Act" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rehabilitation of Minorities (Victims of Terrorism) Endowment Fund, Act 2020;
 - (b) "Form" means a form appended to these rules; and
 - (c) "Scrutiny Committee" means a Scrutiny Committee constituted under rule 4 of these rules.
 - (2) All other words and expression used but not defined in these rules, shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in these rules.
 - ¹[3. Limit of compensation amount.—— (1) The specified amount of compensation to be approved by the Committee, subject to the nature and extent of harm to victims, shall be as per specification given in the Table below:

(2) The Committee may, subject to availability of Fund, approve the financial support to be provided to the permanent disabled victim or, as the case may be, family member of the deceased victim, i.e. widow, widower, parents and minor children of the deceased victim, on yearly basis:

Provided further that in case of minor children, the financial support shall continue till attaining the age of eighteen years.

- (3) The profit of the seed money shall be paid in the following manner, namely:
- (a) payment of compensation under Serial No. 1 of the Table in sub-rule (1);
- (b) after payment of compensation under clause (a) above, payment of annual profit shall be made at the rate of sixty percent (60%) and forty percent (40%) for the purpose of financial support and treatment, under sub-rule (1) in serial No. 2 and 3 of the Table, respectively:

Provided that the Committee may re-allocate, the percentage so fixed under this clause, for the reasons to be recorded in writing.

- (4) A victim or a family member of the deceased victim, as the case may be, once compensated or assisted for any event/disaster etc under these rules shall not be entitled to claim any other compensation under any other law for the time being inforce.]
- 4. Constitution of Scrutiny Committee.—(1) To assist the Committee, there shall be constituted a Scrutiny Committee at District level to examine and scrutinize the applications, which shall consist of the following:
 - (a) Additional Deputy Commissioner (Finance) of the Chairperson concerned District;

(b)	ASP/DSP Headquarter;	Member
(c)	District Health Officer or his representative;	Member
(d)	Tehsildar of the concerned Revenue Circle;	Member
(e)	Halda Patwari and Moharrar: and	Member

- (f) representative of Special Branch not below the rank of Member BS-17.
- (2) The Chairperson may nominate any other member as Co-opted member of the Scrutiny Committee on need basis.
- 5. Application Form.—The application shall be submitted to Scrutiny Committee by the victims himself or in case of his death or disability by his family members as the case may be on the prescribed format at Form I, II and III.
- 6. Preference of family members in case of death of victims.— The amount of compensation shall be distributed amongst the family members of the deceased as per inheritance Law of concerned religion or sect.
- 7. Mode of payments.— The amount of compensation shall be issued through cross-cheque in the name of victim or legal heir in case of deceased as the case may be.
- 8. Management and control of Funds.——(1) The Funds shall be kept in the Bank in the name of the "Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rehabilitation of Minorities (Victims of Terrorism) Endowment Fund" on competitive markup rates.
- (2) The Bank account for the Fund shall be operated jointly by the Chairman and Member-cum-Secretary of the Committee.
- (3) No amount, from the Fund shall be withdrawn, unless it is approved by the Assessment Committee.
- (4) Withdrawal of amount from the fund shall be permissible only under the joint signature of the Chairman and Member-cum-Secretary of the Committee.
- (5) The Committee shall be responsible to collect statement of account from the Bank of the respective account for reconciliation with the account statement.
- Account of the Funds.— Committee shall be responsible for maintenance of accounts of the funds regularly in their quarterly meetings.
- Audit and Accounts.— The Accounts of the Fund shall be audited by the Auditor General of Pakistan as per audit procedure.






