Environmental Protection Agency would like to collaborate with SUPARCO in this regard especially for effective policy making which may help the Agency in making informed decisions and better planning.

2. Secondly, SUPARCO's already extending support to KP Forest, Environment & Wildlife Department on the use of "Satellite Remote Sensing and GIS" for climate change assessments, environmental monitoring, forest mapping, carbon stock assessment, etc. in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. After detailed deliberations, following new technical proposals/concept notes/working papers were shared by SUPARCO;

- a. PC-1 "Investigation of Sources of Fine Atmospheric Particulate Matter and Development Geospatial Database for Informed Decision Making in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa"

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to convey that the Climate Change, Forestry, Environment and Wildlife Department is making concerted efforts to address climate change challenges by implementing national and international commitments. These efforts are being guided by strategic instruments such as the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC), National Climate Change Policy, KP Climate Change Policy, and KP Climate Change Action Plan.

In this regard, the development of a Provincial Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Inventory represents a critical step toward achieving Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's mitigation targets and aligning provincial policies with a low-carbon development trajectory. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), as the focal agency for climate change, intends to seek technical assistance from the UNDP's National Governance Programme (NGP) in the following areas:

1. **Development of Provincial GHG Inventory** to establish a baseline for NDC implementation across key mitigation sectors.
 - o Prioritization of the Industrial Processes and Product Use (IPPU) sector, with an emphasis on collecting plant-level data to progress toward Tier 2 emission factors for high-impact sub-sectors.
2. **Technical support for strengthening the MIS/GIS Cell** within EPA for the purpose of effective GHG emission monitoring.
3. **Capacity-building and training programs** for relevant provincial departments on NDC implementation mechanisms.
4. **Development of Long-Term Low Emissions Development Strategies (LT-LEDs)** tailored to the provincial context.

In light of the above, it is requested that the Planning & Development Department kindly forward this request to the UNDP National Governance Programme and facilitate the provision of technical assistance for the development of the Provincial GHG Inventory and related areas, please.
