Subject: - **RESOLUTION No. 238 ADOPTED BY THE PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY
OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA.**

Dear Sir,

I am directed to say that the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in its sitting held on **13-04-2026** passed unanimously the following Resolution No.238 moved by Mr. Fateh-ul-Mulk Ali Nasir, Member Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa:-

“This esteemed House is well aware of the current global energy crisis that has been brought about by the political tensions in the Middle East and the resulting closure of the Straits of Hormuz. Renewable energy is key to energy self-sufficiency and can ensure that our province and our nation will no longer be susceptible to such international development which may curtail the availability of hydrocarbons.

Acknowledging that Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has immense renewable energy potential including hydro, solar and wind power.

Accepting that developing these resources will lead to our province being a pioneer in environmentally friendly and economically feasible energy production on global level.

Therefore, it is proposed before this House that the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa must start a hybrid renewable energy program that will provide an additional 1000 megawatts of electricity within the near further. This comprehensive program will include.

- 600 megawatts of hydro power to be generated by small and medium capacity projects in Chitral, Dir and Kohistan and all other Districts.
- 350 megawatts of solar power from the southern Districts.
- 50 megawatts from wind power generated in the high and middle altitude regions of Chitral.

Furthermore it is accepted that our province has the capacity to produce far more energy than this but this is a flagship program keeping in mind financial constraints that our provincial government may be facing.

This August House demand that this program be approved by the provincial government on an emergency and existential basis for the greater good of the people of Pakistan”

You are, therefore requested that action taken on the resolution may be intimated to this Secretariat within a period of ninety days from the date of its communication under sub-rule (2) of Rule 165 of the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Procedure and Conduct of Business Rules, 2025 for circulation amongst the Members of the Assembly.
