9. THE MATTERS RAISED BY MR. UBAID-UR-REHMAN, MPA REGARDING THE PROBLEMS FACED BY OVERSEAS PAKISTANIS IN THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES AND WORST LOAD SHEDDING IN HIS CONSTITUENCY (PK-17 LOWER DIR-IV). The above-captioned matters were discussed in the House, thereafter the Chair directed the Provincial Government to take up the matter with Federal Government to take the matter seriously and direct the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to immediately raise the issue regarding problems faced by overseas Pakistanis in the United Arab Emirates, with the Government of the United Arab Emirates and regarding the issue of load shedding, the Chair also gave direction to Chief Executive Officer (CEO), PESCO, to brief all the Hon'ble Members on the issue and provide a proper load-shedding schedule.
