

SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS MONDAY, THE 30TH SEPTEMBER, 2019

Proceedings of the House commenced with recitation from the Holy Quran followed by its Urdu translation at 2:27 P.M. Mr. Mushtaq Ahmad Ghani, Speaker, Provincial Assembly was in the chair whereas in later half Mr. Muhammad Zahir Shah, MPA/chairman from the panel of chairmen presided the sitting.

6. CONSIDERATION OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA EXCISE DUTY ON MINERALS (LABOUR WELFARE) BILL, 2019. Upon the motion of Dr. Amjad Ali, Minister for minerals, the above-captioned Bill was taken into consideration by the House. Amendment in clause 1 was moved by Mr. Inayatullah, MPA but on the request of concerned Minister consideration of the Bill was deferred.
